# Songwriting contest

## General rules

- The song must have complete lyrics, melody and structure.
- The song must be about any of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals.
- The lyrics should be appropriate for all audiences.
- The language of the song must be English, in order for the message to be understood internationally.
- The song will be sent in video format, where the melody and lyrics can be clearly heard. Although it is appreciated, instrumental accompaniment is not required.
- If you can't sing but you can compose, you can ask someone to sing your song in the video.
- The song must be accompanied by a cover letter detailing: written lyrics, composers, meaning of the song, main motivation for participating and style in which you would like to record the song if it wins.
- There is no limit to the number of participants per song.
- A maximum of 3 songs per composer can be submitted.
- The song must be submitted before the end of the first quarter.
- The jury will be composed of a multidisciplinary team. Originality, lyrics and melody will be valued.
- The musical arrangements of the song will not be judged, as the contest is for song composition, not musical production.
- The CIT organization reserves the right to award the prize to the song it deems appropriate. The non-winning songs may be presented in other editions of the contest.
- The winning song will be registered in the name of the authors. The musical production will belong to the CIT organization.
- The publication and distribution of the production made on the winning song will be the responsibility of CIT, worldwide.
